PASTOR: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

ALL: Amen.

PASTOR: LORD God, we are not always prepared to welcome You. While You hope to bring us into Your eternal heavenly Kingdom, that very idea somehow offends us.

ALL: We feel invaded! You want Your way for our lives, but we want ours, and so we rebel. We rebel against Your reign, against Your perfect loving goodness.


