+ Confession and Forgiveness

PASTOR: LORD God, we struggle to understand why You would love our enemies. And even when we accept the fact that You do, we struggle with You wanting us to love them, too.

ALL: How can we love those who hate us? How can we possibly care for those we despise?

PASTOR: That's not how human beings are...

ALL: ... which shows our brokenness. It is not natural for us to love.

PASTOR: Good news: the Bible tells us "God is love." If anyone can fix us, ending our grudges and replacing them with honest love, it is the LORD. That's why He came to us as Jesus Christ, forgave our every sin at the cross, and rose again to give you a new and eternal life in His heavenly Kingdom. God did all of that so you might learn to forgive as He has forgiven, to love as He loves. That is why we worship the LORD today!
