Lighting of the Advent Candles

Advent is the period of four weeks that prepare us for Christmas. The word itself means 'forthcoming' in Latin, because Advent is a celebration of waiting, of anticipating Christ Jesus' arrival in our world.

There are three episodes of 'forthcoming' that Christians observe during Advent. The first happened about 2,000 years ago when Jesus – God Himself – entered into our human existence as a baby. He then lived a wholly good life, a life He came to willingly sacrificed on the cross. Three days later, Jesus Christ rose again, promising forgiveness of sins and eternal life to all who know and follow Him. This gives us the second 'forthcoming' – yes, it happens to us today! Jesus offers to enter into our lives, to guide us through every twist and turn. Finally, the third 'forthcoming' will happen in the future. Jesus has promised to return to us, to complete the never-ending age of God's Kingdom. Please join us now as we eagerly await the coming of Christ Jesus!

PASTOR: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

ALL: Amen.

PASTOR: Almighty God, we have gathered today to wait. We join the people of the Bible who, from the very beginning, have waited for their reunion with You.

ALL: We wait for Heaven on earth, for Your eternal Paradise.


