The diminishing light symbolizes the fading devotion of Christ's followers – the disciples – and our own sins, which add to the world's spiritual gloom. At the end of the worship service, the sanctuary will be as dark and silent as Christ's tomb.

ALL: Almighty God, You came to us. When You lived among us as Christ Jesus, You shown like a pure light in our dim world, the Light meant to guide us all. That Light still shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

You entered into the very world You created, but the world did not recognize You. Humanity, Your dearest creation, rejected You. But we have heard the good news: whoever does believe, whoever accepts You, will become a child of God.
