PASTOR: LORD God, we feel so powerless!

ALL: Every day gives us new troubles, and we doubt we can handle them. It feels like we're just barely getting by, so doing something more or different seems impossible, even if it's good and needed work – even if it's sharing Your love.

PASTOR: But You have promised us a peace we can't understand, refreshed strength, and even Your power.

#### ALL: Can we believe it?

PASTOR: God came as Jesus Christ to offer us a new life, a neverending life with Him. We might feel flawed and useless, but Christ paid for all of our failures on the cross. He forgave every sin. Three days later, He rose again, bringing the promise of Heaven when there was once only death. Nothing is the same if you find life in Jesus! We no longer need to feel powerless, because He gives everything you need and more, and that is why we worship the LORD today.
