Welcome to our Good Friday Tenebrae Worship Service! *Tenebrae* is the Latin word for "shadows", and this type of worship has been practiced in the Christian Church since the fourth century. During the service, while thirteen candles are extinguished, our readers will recall the events that led to Jesus Christ's suffering and death on the cross. The diminishing light symbolizes the fading devotion of Christ's followers – the disciples – and our own sins, which add to the world's spiritual gloom. At the end of the worship service, the sanctuary will be as dark and silent as Christ's tomb.

+ Prayer of the Day – based on John 1:4b-5, 10-13

ALL: Almighty God, You came to us. When You lived among us as Christ Jesus, You shown like a pure light in our dim world, the Light meant to guide us all. That Light still shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

You entered into the very world You created, but the world did not recognize You. Humanity, Your dearest creation, rejected You. But we have heard the good news: whoever does believe, whoever accepts You, will become a child of God. We were once children of the darkness, but Your life, death, and return from the grave change us into children of the Light! Amen.

Confession and Forgiveness – based on Isaiah 53:3-12 PASTOR: He was despised and rejected... ALL: ... a man of sorrows who knew true grief.

PASTOR: We turned our backs on Him, despising and ignoring Him. **ALL: But He still carried our suffering.**

PASTOR: We thought His troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for His own sins!

ALL: ... but He was pierced for our rebellion and crushed for our sins.

PASTOR: The punishment we deserved was laid on Him, and so we are healed by His bruises. His sacrifice makes us whole.

ALL: Like sheep, we have all wandered. We have strayed from God's path to follow our own...

PASTOR: ... but the LORD laid that sin on Him. He was oppressed and afflicted...

ALL: ... but He did not protest.

PASTOR: He was led to the slaughter like a lamb...

ALL: ... but He did not protest.

PASTOR: He was taken away and sentenced to death. He was unjustly condemned.

PASTOR: He was cut off from the land of the living.

ALL: And laid in a grave with the wicked.

PASTOR: He was innocent, but it was the LORD's good plan to crush Him with pain.

ALL: His life was offered to defeat sin.

PASTOR: The One who is right and good, the LORD's servant, will make many people righteous by taking their sins...

ALL: ... and they will share in His victory!

PASTOR: He poured Himself out to death, dying like a sinner to carry the sins of many.

ALL: He carried our sin to forgive our sins.
